Is 58:7-10 | 1 Cor 2:1-5 | Mt 5:13-16

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

My understanding of prayer changed when I read St. Teresa of Calcutta's statement that says, "I used to believe that prayer changes things, but now I know that prayer changes us and we change things." Prayer is not an incantation that can change the will of God. It is the act of raising our hearts and minds to God, and of opening ourselves — our will, our understanding, our joys, and our sorrows — to be sanctified. The prophet Isaiah seems to be saying something similar in the first reading. He lists off the commands of the Lord to clothe the naked, feed the hungry, and shelter the homeless, and then tells the faithful that if they do these things, "then your light shall break forth like the dawn." We certainly serve those who are vulnerable because each person has immeasurable dignity and deserves to be cared for as a child of God. But the act of caring for another also changes us. We are made more fully into who we were created to be — not an individual living in isolation, but one who is deeply connected in community to the rest of humankind.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

An act of service, then, is much bigger than simply donating money or giving of our time. In caring for our neighbor, we proclaim God's goodness to a world in darkness, bearing witness to the love of God which is the source of all our actions. In the Gospel, Christ calls his followers to be "the light of the world," reminding us that he wants to shine his light through us. But we are not the source of the light. Even when we are the ones serving, we still remain only the vessel the true light shines through. When we love others, we are changed because we allow ourselves to be conformed more closely to Christ, allowing others to encounter his love in our actions.

SERVE

The corporal works of mercy are to feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty, clothe the naked, shelter the homeless, visit the sick, visit the imprisoned, and bury the dead. This is not a list meant to overwhelm, but rather to provide opportunities to care for God's children. What act of service can you and your family engage in this week to allow the light of Christ to shine through you?

Sacramental Timelines:

What to Expect

Hey everyone! I thought I'd take my space this Sunday to give a heads up about different timelines for receiving different Sacraments. Our American culture has us wanting what we desire the moment we desire it, which can be frustrating when the Catholic Church doesn't operate like that! So please keep the following in mind if you foresee it applying to you or your children.



Infant Baptism

This requires a 2-part class and each is held on the 1st Sunday of the month. Some choose to wait until after the child is born to attend them but this is not required. If you feel that it will be easier to attend them before the child is born, feel free to go to our website and fill out the online inquiry to begin the process at your convenience.

Adults Seeking Baptism or Confirmation

This process, called OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation for Adults), runs year-round but doesn't necessarily take a year to complete. It involves group meetings, teaching and discussion on various topics, and, for the most part, anyone can jump in at any time to begin the process.

It's preferable that adult baptisms and confirmations occur at the Easter Vigil, but it's ALSO preferable that the person become baptized and confirmed when both the parish and the person agree that they're ready. If you're interested, fill out the inquiry online (under "Becoming Catholic") and schedule a meeting with me and I'll explain more.

Marriage

Though we seek to make your wedding beautiful and memorable, our main focus is preparing couples for marriage. There are a handful of elements required for marriage prep that take time and can't be rushed at the last minute.

The parish requires at least 6 months for marriage prep, though 8 months to a year is preferred. This timeline doesn't apply though if there's a past marriage involved. If that's the case, please do not wait until you are engaged before you set up a meeting and talk to one of the priests. For what it's worth though, they made me do 6 YEARS of prep in order to get ordained...

Anointing of the Sick/Last Rites

I lied... this Sacrament can and SHOULD be rushed if needed (as well as baptism in danger of death). This Sacrament is to be administered to in danger of death due to sickness or old age or life-threatening surgery. Priests make this a priority when they're called but please do not wait until the last minute in case you can't reach one. Our emergency line for this is 614-231-4509 but hospitals have their own priests as chaplains to administer the Sacrament.

In addition, the giving of alms is one way to share God's gifts—not only through the distribution of money, but through the sharing of our time and talents. As St. John Chrysostom reminds us: "Not to enable the poor to share in our goods is to steal from them and deprive them of life. The goods we possess are not ours, but theirs."
