## Message from Christy Deberson

*I am Always With You*



On this 4th Sunday of Lent we celebrate and we rejoice in hope. Known as Laetare Sunday, the 4th Sunday of Lent is a day of celebration within the otherwise austere period of Lent, marked by the use of rose-colored vestments and a focus on joy and hope, with the name "Laetare" meaning "rejoice" in Latin.

We can use this week to reflect and rejoice in God's love and to hope in Him. How can we spread love and grow closer to Him? At the beginning of Lent, Pope Francis shared his message as he said, "Let us journey together in hope."

During the season of Lent our preschool classes are singing a song called "This is Lent." The first line of the song, sung to the tune of *Frere Jacques*, is "Prayer and Fasting, and Almsgiving..." Almsgiving is a word that most children are not familiar with, and maybe even some adults, but almsgiving is a way we can show God's love to others.

Using simple terms with the children, we explain that Almsgiving is being kind. We ask the children how we can be kind to those in our community. Some classes have the children share their acts of kindness at group time, and we celebrate those acts and also talk about how this brings us all closer together.

Working with young children affords all of us at the preschool the joy of seeing so many moments of kindness which renew our hope in our next generations. I will leave you this week with one of those moments of pure unprovoked kindness.

On a Thursday morning a group of children were sitting on the floor. One girl turns to another and says "I heard you cry sometimes when I leave early." The second girl responds "I do." The first child hugs her and says, "Remember I am always with you." They both smiled. Just like Jesus. He is always with us.

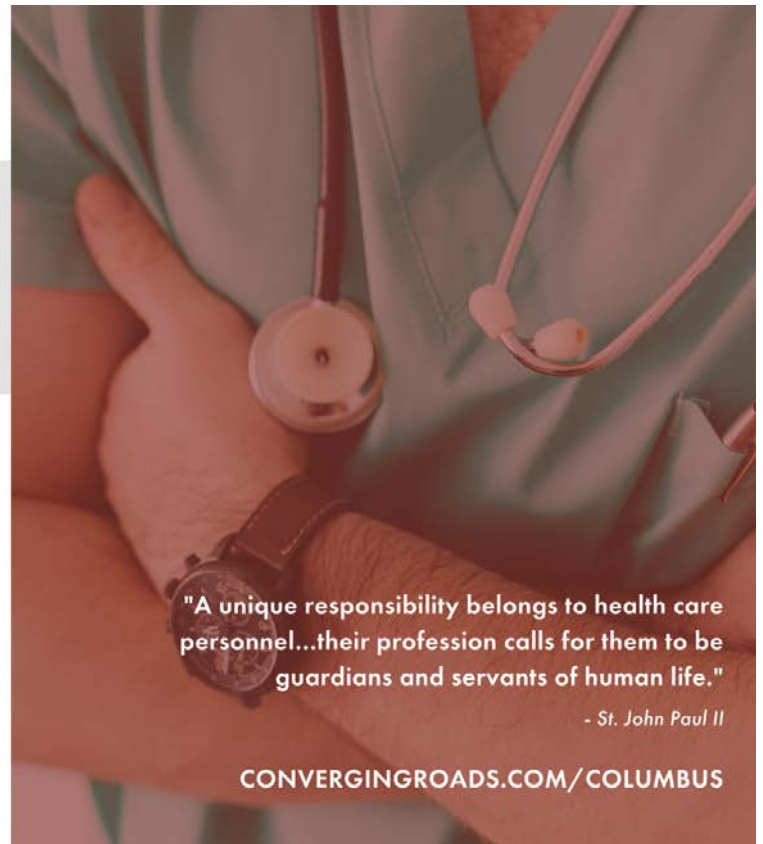

### PRAYER, FASTING, ALMSGIVING

During Lent, we are asked to devote ourselves to seeking the Lord in prayer and reading Scripture, to service by giving alms, and to practice self-control through fasting.

Many know of the tradition of abstaining from meat on Fridays during Lent, but we are also called to exercise self-discipline and fast in other ways throughout the season.

In addition, the giving of alms is one way to share God's gifts—not only through the distribution of money, but through the sharing of our time and talents. As St. John Chrysostom reminds us: "Not to enable the poor to share in our goods is to steal from them and deprive them of life. The goods we possess are not ours, but theirs."

#### How do we fast?

When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

#### Am I excused from fasting and abstinence?

Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the physically or mentally ill including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes. Also excluded are pregnant or nursing women.

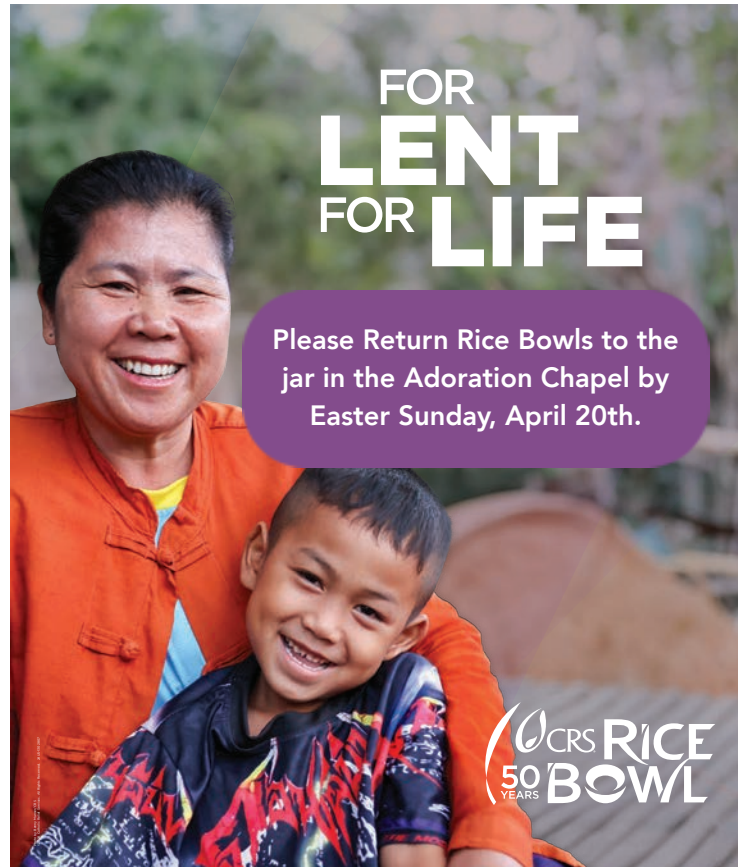

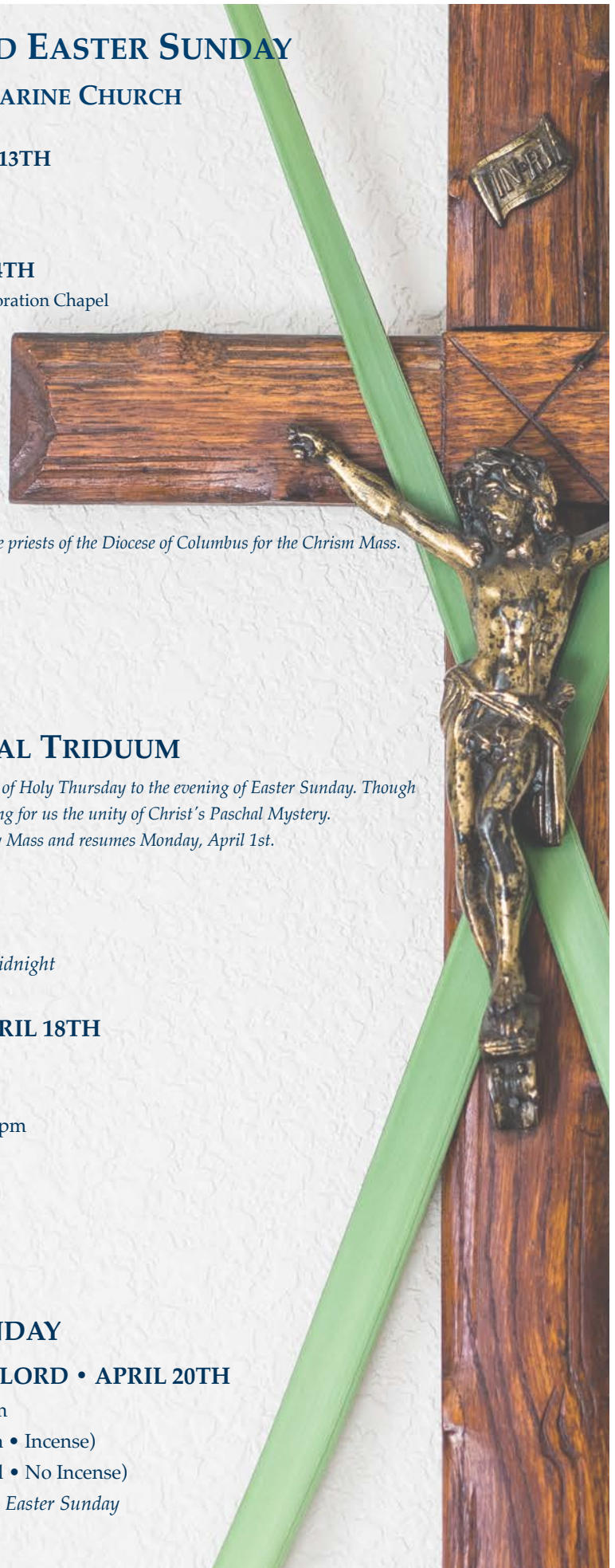

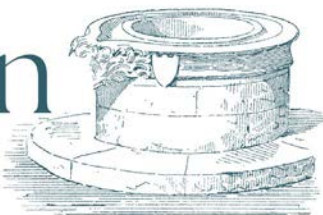

# Fourth Sunday of Lent

## GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

We await with anticipation holidays and holiday parties – but do we look forward to the day after? To the cleanup, the back-to-the-grind, the business-as-usual? Jesus' parable in today's Gospel recounts the lavish celebration of the father who rejoices at the homecoming of his wayward son. We rightly recognize in the father's mercy the abundant forgiveness of our heavenly Father. But have we ever considered what happened the next day? The son, accustomed to his independence and dissolute life, is once again in his father's house. He must live according to his father's rules and demonstrate the sincerity of his repentance by faithfully carrying out his duties. There is work to be done – crops to be harvested, perhaps. As the weeks and months pass without another fatted calf for feasting, the son might ask if his father's love has waned. And although we may sympathize with his unease, the certainty of his father's goodness must be, for the prodigal son and for us, the guarantee of his steadfast love.

## GO EVANGELIZE

### PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

In our relationship with God, we will likely experience moments when our Father's love is keenly felt. Perhaps we will be overwhelmed with peace when we return to him in the sacrament of confession. Perhaps we will be struck by a verse of Scripture during a moment of prayer. But most of our days will look more like the prodigal son's "day after" than the festivities which marked his return. We know, however, that if the weeks that followed were comparatively boring, his father's love had lost none of its warmth or vitality. Similarly, in the days when God seems quiet, when our prayers seem to drift into space or our hearts are distracted with the concerns of everyday life, we must not despair of the Father's love. Nor can we suppose that our happiness can be found outside of his fold. We abide under the care of our Father who lovingly calls us to himself with every circumstance he places before us. To believe this, even when the festivities are over, is to live by faith.

## PRAY

With so many opportunities for gratification at our fingertips, it is easy to become restless and to seek happiness in distractions. This week, find an image of Jesus or a Scripture verse about God's love and keep it with you as you work, study, or carry out monotonous tasks. When you're tempted to leave your duties aside out of boredom, take a moment instead to praise and thank God for his love.

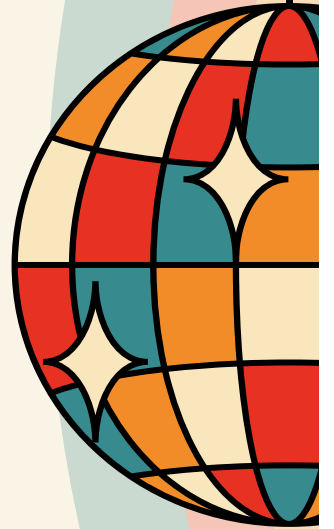

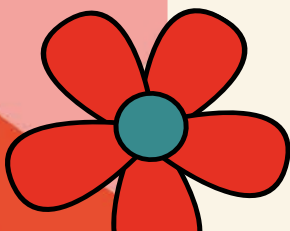
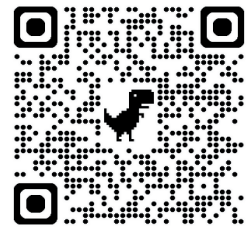
