

The Baptism of the Lord

Is 42:1-4, 6-7 | Acts 10:34-38 | Mt 3:13-17

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

We hear in today's Gospel that at the moment of Jesus' baptism, "a voice came from the heavens, saying, 'This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased.'" We can hear these words as a simple proclamation of who Jesus is — the beloved Son of God — but also as a proclamation of who we are called to be: the beloved adopted sons and daughters of God. I sometimes forget that I am also called beloved. I mistakenly think that my value depends on my accomplishments or on my faithfulness, but the truth is that my status as beloved is due to being made in the image of my Creator. If I allow myself to absorb the full meaning of that, it will not only affect how I view myself but also how I relate to others. But Christ didn't come only to show us the truth about who we are. His coming also invites us to see one another as beloved. As Peter reminds us in our second reading, "God shows no partiality." May we strive to see the belovedness that God bestows on us and on all people.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Jesus entered fully into our humanity, including entering into communion with each of us through our common baptism, to allow for us to one day share in the perfect exchange of love of the Trinity. Our call is to take on Christ's mission of love here on earth — to speak and act in a way that proclaims the truth of who God is and who he has made us to be. How can we remind our families, our neighbors, and even our enemies of their nature as beloved children of God? And by recognizing our own nature as beloved, we allow God's grace to flow through us. We then trust that God will make himself known as the source of love itself.

REFLECT

Take time this week to reflect on what it means to be a beloved son or daughter of God. What would it be like to hear, "You are my beloved child, with whom I am well pleased"? Once we root ourselves in this truth we can ask ourselves, "What act of kindness, what consoling word might I offer, what goodness might I do for others around me to help them experience a glimpse of their own belovedness?" Then, do it!

When Jesus Enters the Room

Pope St. John Paul II wrote in his encyclical *Ecclesia de Eucharistia* that, "the Eucharist, as Christ's saving presence in the community of the faithful and its spiritual food, is the most precious possession which the Church can have in her journey through history" (*Ecclesia de Eucharistia* 9).



The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life. Without the nourishment it provides, we can do nothing! Through the years, I have been able to see the power of the Lord in the Eucharist many times. In sudden conversions, physical and mental healings, and an abundance of grace for unexpected situations, Jesus has made known His power through the True Presence of the Eucharist! There is one story which I often reflect upon as showing the truth and power of the Eucharist.

A few summers ago, I had the opportunity to serve on program staff at Damascus Catholic Mission Campus during a week of Catholic Youth Summer Camp (CYSC). About halfway through the summer, I had this amazing group of high school girls in my small prayer group. They were all interested in the Catholic faith, but somewhat cautious about diving in. One girl in particular told me that she didn't believe in God at all. Yet throughout the week, I was able to witness their hearts begin to shift toward the truth and love Jesus offers. They were all asking questions related to the faith and began to open up during small group. It culminated on that Thursday night, when we had adoration. We were all sitting together and preparing for adoration by singing praise and worship. When we heard the bells ringing, indicating that Jesus was entering the room, we began to kneel. At that moment, Emily (who didn't believe in God before) turned to me and, with a look of great excitement and delight, said, "Maggie! Jesus is coming!"

And in that simple phrase, I understood that Emily, and the rest of my prayer lab, had come to know and believe in the presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. This encounter deeply changed them—throughout the rest of the night they began to experience the Lord's presence in powerful ways. Although they walked into the week unsure and unconfident, they left consumed with the love of Jesus through their encounter with Him in the Eucharist. It also intensely struck my own heart with the depth of beauty found in the Eucharist. With this in mind, I invite you to ponder the reality of the Eucharist and allow it to set your heart on fire for Jesus. The Eucharist indeed is the most precious possession of the Church.




