Corpus Christi: It's Not Just a Fancy Name

It's me—Bentley, your faithful parish dog, happily reporting in for one of my favorite feast days of the year: Corpus Christi Sunday! It's the day we celebrate the greatest mystery ever tucked inside something so small: the Eucharist—Jesus Himself, hidden in a humble host.

Now, I may not be able to receive Communion (apparently canon law has something to say about that), but even I can tell the Eucharist is special. I see how gently you receive Him. I notice the stillness that fills the Adoration Chapel. I feel the peace that lingers long after Mass is over. It's like Jesus is saying, "I'm here. I love you. Stay close."



One holy human who understood this more than most was St. Mother Teresa. She once said:

"When you look at the crucifix, you understand how much Jesus loved you then. When you look at the Eucharist, you understand how much He loves you now."

I think about that a lot (in between naps and squirrel surveillance). Jesus isn't just a figure from long ago—He's with us, right now, offering us strength, mercy, and love in every single Mass. That's what makes today so paws-itively amazing.

To celebrate, we're taking Jesus out into the world—literally! Join us for our Corpus Christi Procession at 2:00 PM, starting at Christ the King. We'll walk with the Eucharist through the neighborhood, letting our streets become a kind of open-air chapel. There'll be a water station along the route, and rides available afterward to bring folks back to Christ the King. (The Procession will end here at St. Catharine, and NOT continue onto St. Thomas due to some road construction.)

So come celebrate with full hearts, comfy shoes, and maybe some sunscreen. Let your steps, your songs, and your prayers speak what we believe: Jesus is in the Eucharist. Jesus is with us. And Jesus is everything.

Jesus comes to be near us—and we, in turn, walk with Him. Happy Corpus Christi!

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

Gen 14:18-20 | 1 Cor 11:23-26 | Lk 9:11b-17

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Today's feast is set apart to reverence the gift of Jesus in the Eucharist. In our limited human capacity, this concept can feel abstract, and we may struggle to understand it. In these moments, I find that pondering the person of Jesus Christ in the Gospels illuminates my mind and heart. Hearing the familiar story of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes in today's Gospel, I'm particularly struck by the first line of the passage: "Jesus spoke to the crowds about the kingdom of God, and he healed those who needed to be cured," Notice that Luke doesn't say that Jesus heals everyone, rather, he heals those who need to be cured. This is not an act of favoritism, but a revelation of his perfect divine wisdom and a glimpse into the true person of Jesus Christ. In his great mercy and perfect love. Jesus knew instantly what each person needed. And this Jesus, who came to heal and cure, is the one we receive in the Eucharist today.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Today's feast is a reminder of the staggering truth that 2,000 years later, at every Eucharistic celebration in Catholic churches around the world, Christ becomes truly present. The same Jesus of the Gospels who taught the crowds, multiplied the loaves, and gave himself completely on the cross, gives himself to us *today:* body, blood, soul, and divinity. We are not unlike the crowds in today's Gospel — we have come with our hopes and needs to encounter Jesus. Today, at this table, no one goes hungry; Jesus meets our needs by giving us his unconditional love while nourishing us both physically and spiritually. We can be reassured that God is always present in our lives.

REFLECT

In a special way today, reflect on the Eucharist, the "source and summit of the Christian life." The word Eucharist comes from Greek and Latin words for "thanksgiving." Pray with a grateful heart today that Jesus, the Bread of Life, makes himself truly present to us.

"I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me shall not hunger, and whoever believes in me shall never thirst." (Jn 6:35)






