

FAMILY OF FAITH

Family of Faith brings St. Catharine families together to learn about the life of Jesus Christ, His teachings, and our Catholic Faith. At home, parents will help their children fall in love with Jesus as they journey toward Heaven as a family.

Beginning in September, families with children in grades 1-8 will gather to experience our Faith through discussion and activities.

There is an important change this year, after helpful suggestions from participating families - children and parents will often have separate experiences on campus at St. Catharine.

Parents will share meaningful discussion with other parents. In a separate area, children will enjoy games and activities on the same topic with our joyful catechists and other children.

Family of Faith will use Seek and Root this year, new activity kits from Faith and Family Life Ministries, to lead families deeper into their Faith.

Throughout the month parents will also do some Seek and Root activities as a family at home to learn and experience our Catholic Faith together.

CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a hands-on method of faith formation based on the Montessori method of learning. Children come to the atrium each week to learn with extensively trained catechists. The atrium is a special place of work and prayer, filled with kid-sized furniture and hands on models of people, places, and items found in Scripture and liturgy. Each week, the children choose "work" to continue their meditation about particular Scripture texts or signs from the liturgy. Working with these materials allows the child to enter more deeply into meditation, nurturing their relationship with the good Shepherd.

We currently offer CGS for pre-K, Kindergarten, and first graders attending St. Catharine School during the school day. For 3-6 year olds who are not attending the school, CGS is offered on Sunday and Wednesday mornings.

Children preparing to receive the Sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation participate in Family of Faith and prepare with catechists on retreats and several additional sessions throughout the year.

WHY FOCUS ON THE FAMILY?

Good question!

Along with leaders in our Diocese, we have learned from experience that simply being dropped off for PSR in a classroom does not have a great enough impact on the development of a child's Faith. We want to help families grow in Faith together, with parents and children involved in fun activities and conversations that lay a strong foundation for Faith.

St. Catharine hopes to support you in your work of educating your little ones in the Catholic Faith, and provide you with the tools you need so that Faith becomes woven into the fabric of your family.



To enroll your child in formation for Sacraments, register for Family of Faith. Preparation for First Reconciliation and First Communion is a two year program, which can begin as early as first grade. Preparation for Confirmation is also a two year program, which can begin as early as seventh grade.



St. Catharine Sandwich Crew

The Sandwich Crew began providing sandwiches, salty and sweet snacks to Holy Family Soup Kitchen as Covid began. These supplement the daily bags that are given to soup kitchen guests to take with them after receiving a meal or help there. Very often the food in these bags is the only other meal(s) for those living on the streets or for families without a home or working kitchen. The need is great and is growing daily.

Here's how it works:

Sandwiches: Simple sandwiches (bologna, pbj, cured meat like salami, etc.) are needed. Other types can spoil and many can't refrigerate food items. Each sandwich is put in an individual sandwich bag.

Salty and sweet snacks: Individual bags of chips, pretzels, crackers, cheese and crackers, peanut butter crackers, cookies, dried fruits like raisins, granola bars, and Nutri Grain bars for those without teeth.

You can provide whatever you like and however much you can – sandwiches, snacks or both.

If you can help, let us know about how much you can provide and how often. We need to let Holy Family know how much is coming each week.
