

Message from John Haemmerle

What Mothers Can Teach Us About Our Father



Happy Mother's day! Mother's Day is a wonderful holiday when we set aside time to thank and honor our mothers for all that they do. The love and care of our mothers is often overlooked and taken for granted, so today is a good reminder for all of us of the wonderful gift that our mothers are!

I always enjoy when secular celebrations coincide with Mass readings that are set to a different rotation. Our Gospel today is a perfect example of this. Jesus tells us that His sheep hear His voice and follow Him. His sheep cannot be taken out of His hand. These aspects of the Gospel can be informed by our experiences of our mothers. St. Thomas Aquinas says that all of the good qualities in the things around us exist perfectly in God.

There are two aspects of motherhood that I think can point towards our relationship with God. The first is the love that mothers tirelessly embody. This faithful and unceasing love of mothers shows us a faint glimpse of the love that God has for each of us. God's love for each of us far surpasses the love of even the most sacrificial mother. As we celebrate our mothers, we should also take time to reflect upon the perfect love that God has for us.

The other aspect of motherhood is the way in which our mothers teach us. It is our mother's voice that we come to recognize and trust. In this sense our mothers give us an image of the voice of the Good Shepherd who speaks to us as He leads us to green pastures and to restful waters.

If these qualities have not been your experience of your mother, or if you have lost your mother, take hope knowing that from the cross Jesus gave us His mother to be our mother also. Mary extends her love and direction to us as she seeks to lead us closer to the heart of her Son! Let us give thanks to God for the abundance with which He provides for us!

One way your children can come to experience more deeply the love that God has for each of us and the tenderness of our Blessed Mother is through attending our week-long summer day program from June 8-13 called Totus Tuus (latin for Totally Yours). Through this program the children of our parish will be led deeper in their relationship with God through devotion to the Eucharist and to our Blessed Mother Mary! 

Fourth Sunday of Easter

Acts 13:14, 43-52 | Rev 7:9, 14b-17 | Jn 10:27-30

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

"My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me." The spiritual riches contained in this line alone are enough to sustain us for a lifetime. First, we rejoice that Jesus, the Good Shepherd, calls us his own. We belong to him who, like the shepherds of bygone days, protects his sheep - capable of little in the way of self-defense - even at the cost of his own life. Also, among the distinctive marks of Jesus' sheep are that they hear his voice and follow him. Thus, to be part of Christ's flock involves not only being known by him, but knowing him and heeding his call. A sheep who has not attuned its ears to the voice of its shepherd is a lost sheep! Although the world's fertile meadows may look inviting, not to attune our ears to the voice of Christ means exposing ourselves to the dangers of a life apart from God. On the other hand, if we make our pilgrimage of life with him, we abide within the protective confines of his love until the day we follow him into the pastures of eternal life.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Frequently, our free will (something we do not share with sheep) gets in the way of our ability to heed the Shepherd's voice. For us, his voice is expressed in concrete ways: in his commandments, in the teachings and tradition of his Church, in the Scriptures, in our legitimate superiors, and in prayer. These are the means he uses to mark out the path he wishes us to follow. But this path always involves the cross, and our sheep-ish (pun intended) nature recoils at the sight of suffering. In today's second reading, however, St. John's vision offers the key to overcoming our resistance: "For the Lamb who is in the center of the throne will shepherd them." In other words, Jesus, our Divine Shepherd, is also a lamb who has tread the difficult way of the cross. He is the Lamb of God who offered himself in a sacrifice of perfect obedience to his Father's will. Thus, we do not embark along the way of obedience and suffering alone; Jesus walks before us to sustain and protect us along the way.

OBSERVE

Find an image of Jesus as the Good Shepherd online and spend 15 minutes praying about what you see. What is the Shepherd's attitude toward his sheep, and the sheep's attitude toward their Shepherd? What do we learn from this about *our* relationship with Christ?




