## From The Principal's Desk

Is the Life I'm Living Worth the Price He Paid?

When I learned to actually listen to what God's plans were for me, the truth of the Gospel set me free to be who I was always meant to be. I am here because I learned the truth of the Gospel and let the Holy Spirit guide me. I found joy when I actually learned that I was destined to serve others. I owe that commitment to others for what Jesus did for me. It forces me to ask myself...

"Is the life I'm living worth the price He paid?"

There are many qualities and characteristics that are important for personal growth, but they can all be encompassed by three virtues that serve as the foundation for all others. It is not just important to live these virtues personally, but to help others to identify and develop these virtues in order to live a more Christ-like, impactful life.



The first of these virtues is **Humility**. There are many prayers that I consistently read depending on my situation. One of my favorites is also one of the most difficult to

pray. The *Litany of Humility* is such a powerful prayer requiring honest discernment and self-reflection. Experience and gratitude can have a profound effect on humility.

Deliver me from the desire of being esteemed, honored, praised, and approved. Deliver me from the fear of being despised, forgotten, ridiculed, and wronged. For others to be praised, and I go unnoticed, Jesus, grant me the grace to desire it.

The second of these virtues is **Empathy**. In a world that can seemingly revolve around ourselves (according to our secular world), knowing we are not always the main character in our own stories is humbling. That humble realization slowly transforms into gratitude and compassion. This enables young people to serve others without counting the cost of their words and actions.

Empathy is a direct contradiction to the cheapest and lowest form of communication: opinion. Our society is filled with opinions from all ages and backgrounds, and on all mediums. An opinion costs nothing to deliver. However empathy forces us to engage with others in a way that we understand their perspective.


The third of these virtues is **Authenticity**. Young people must know who made them and why. They need to know, even as teenagers, they are the sons and daughters of God and nothing will change that.

Young people also need to know why they are here. They are not a random clump of cells destined to meander through life as a victim of their circumstances. They were put on this earth to love Him and to serve Him by loving and serving others. They need to know they are loved as much as anyone else. That love involves sacrifice and we all have our cross to carry.

The truth of the Gospel legitimizes and opens the door for the most important job in our society today, which is mentoring young people. Teaching, along with coaching, is one of the few professions where standards and expectations can be set for young people, which they are reluctant to do. Motivating young people to become the best versions of themselves requires an in-depth understanding of how they see themselves in our world.

Young people need people they can trust. They have to trust adults enough who tell them about the love of God. Those same adults need to be able to teach young people who Jesus really is. They need to know that the life of someone who lived over 2,000 years ago is just as meaningful in their own lives, today. They cannot love Jesus if they do not know Jesus. Young people are constantly being pulled in every direction except toward the grace of God. The only way they can lead our faith, church, and society is if young people are equipped and empowered with the knowledge of who Jesus is, and why he died for our sins.







## Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord

Acts 1:1-11 | Eph 1:17-23 | Lk 24:46-53

#### GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Every day the world urges us to place our trust in countless things: money, brands, self-improvement methods - all with instant results! As Christians, however, we know that only God's promises are worth betting everything on, and they are not fulfilled on our self-determined timelines. Today's readings portray Jesus, the wounds of his crucifixion still visible, accompanying his followers for 40 days after his resurrection. Now the Apostles, some with questions of their own, are asked to wait once more for "the promise of the Father" of which they heard Jesus speak: baptism by the Holy Spirit on Pentecost. For the Apostles as for us, following Christ is not an easy path, the Apostles likely were wondering what to expect in this "baptism." The fulfillment of God's promises doesn't always happen quickly, nor are we usually able to grasp the big picture at the moment of fulfillment. Nevertheless, it is in these periods of waiting that faith takes root and deepens. Uncertainty makes room for faith, and as the Holy Spirit descends into our life and makes things clear, we see the beauty in God's mysterious and loving plan for us.

#### GO EVANGELIZE

#### PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

There's a saying, "If you want to make God laugh, tell him your plans." It is often a matter of timing and expectations around life that can sew doubt into our faith. In the first reading, the Apostles ask the resurrected Christ if now he would restore the kingdom of Israel. He responds, "It is not for you to know the times or seasons." We are reminded that our faith never obligates us to know what events are to come, and which date in our calendars to mark. Our role, as the second reading says, is to let our "hearts be enlightened, that [we] may know what is the hope that belongs to his call." We wait in faith for the Holy Spirit to move and enlighten us to what God wills. We can rest secure in the assurance that we will be given all we need.

#### PRAY

Is your prayer sometimes full of questions about God's timing and intentions, or are you able to wait in faith for God to act? Ask the Holy Spirit for the faith and hope you need to remain at peace as you wait. Then, keep your eyes fixed on Christ, and be not afraid.


