Father Brown's Files

Feasts, Festivals, and the Fire of Pentecost



Come Holy Spirit! I remember it was FunFest weekend this time last year when I pulled-up to St. Catharine in my U-Haul with all my stuff and moved in. And because everything was so new, I was a little nervous to jump in and drink from the firehose, so I instead hid under a rock in my room...

But I like the timing of the FunFest this year, though, and how it overlaps with the feast of Pentecost, because the understanding of the two is actually tied together.

Not in the sense that Pentecost has anything to do with games and hotdogs, because when we hear the word "festival" today that's what we think of. Festival can be traced back to the latin *festa* meaning "a religious holiday" while "holidays" were understood to be "holy days." I'm not really sure when holiday adopted its secular understanding of being certain days to take time off of obligations in life as opposed to dedicating time to celebrate all things holy, but here we are...

The word also carries the understanding of "joy", which maybe paints the picture of the original understanding of a festival: they're joyful and holy times of celebration (Christmas and Easter are the obvious times where this is most clearly seen.)

Hopefully that sheds some light when we say things like "Eucharistic Feast" or "the feast day of this or that saint." The Feast of Pentecost is no different. Traditionally understood as the birthday of the Church, when the Holy Spirit was sent forth upon the Apostles, Pentecost is ABSOLUTELY a joyful holy day to be celebrated. Festivals and holidays are not times to take a break from God! They're times to celebrate Him!







Pentecost Sunday

Acts 2:1-11 | 1 Cor 12:3b-7, 12-13 | Jn 20:19-23 or Jn 14:15-16, 23b-26

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

In today's first reading, we join the Apostles in the Upper Room. These individuals had accompanied Jesus to his death and been witnesses to his resurrection and ascension. Can you imagine the throes of emotion accompanying each experience? Now, they gather together, perhaps discussing what to do next. They wonder where they should go, and who they should listen to, since Jesus was no longer there: "And suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind." In a moment swelling with grace, tongues of fire descended upon each person present, "and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit." What might this moment have sounded like? Looked like? Felt like? The Apostles were weary and grieving, but Jesus made a promise he intended to keep - that he would send an advocate in his name to teach them everything. That same Spirit now waits to guide and empower us if we are willing to receive him.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Jesus' death left his followers grieving and disoriented. They had left everything to follow him. And now, he was gone. What would become of them? Jesus said: "I have told you this while I am with you. The Advocate, the Holy Spirit whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you." On this feast of Pentecost, Jesus' promise is fulfilled. When the Father sent down the Spirit, it was not just for a singular, grand moment in time; the Spirit came for good. In the same way the Apostles were strengthened by the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, so were we strengthened at our confirmation. We were commissioned, as were they, to live out our faith in the world. When we need strength in this mission, let us remember that the word advocate comes from the Latin word advocatus, which means "one who draws near." Come, Holy Spirit, come!

REFLECT

Read the Veni, Sancte Spiritus ("Come, Holy Spirit") prayer that we heard before the Gospel today. Each line, laden with powerful imagery, invites us to understand the Spirit more intimately. Reflect on where you experience the Holy Spirit in your life today, and where you long for a greater outpouring of his fire.




