Help Make an Authentically Catholic Education Accessible and Affordable for All

Did you know that, in late 2021, the Ohio Legislature passed a law creating a <u>tax credit</u> for qualified donations to scholarship granting organizations certified by the Ohio Attorney General?

The Diocese of Columbus considers affordable access to a Catholic education a philanthropic priority so, in December 2021, the Diocesan Education Corporation (dba Emmaus Road Scholarship Fund) officially was formed and certified as the first Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO) in the state.

How Does It Work?

- Donors who make a gift to the Emmaus Road Scholarship Fund receive a **dollar-for-dollar reduction** of their Ohio tax liability upon filing next year (equal to the amount of the gift up to \$750 or \$1,500 if married and filing jointly).
- Anyone can make a gift! Parents, grandparents, alumni, friends anyone with a heart for making Catholic education accessible and affordable for all. Only Ohio residents will receive the tax credit, but out-of-state residents have the potential to realize a Federal tax savings for their contribution.
- **No gift is too large or too small**, but the Ohio tax credit is limited to \$750 for an individual and \$1,500 if married and filing jointly
- **Your gift can be directed to St. Catharine** or you can make a gift to the general (unrestricted) fund to help the greatest number of students in the diocese, starting with low-income families

Reap the Most Tax Benefit While Supporting St. Catharine

Maximize your giving dollars before the ball drops on New Year's Eve by using funds in your retirement account to support St. Catharine. The IRA Charitable Rollover allows donors who are 70.5 years or older to transfer up to \$100,000 from a traditional or Roth IRA to a qualified charity like The Catholic Foundation. In doing so, donors keep their IRA distribution from impacting their gross income and possibly avoid being bumped into a higher tax bracket. The IRA charitable rollover can also count toward your required minimum distribution (RMD), which starts at age 72. All transfers must be made directly from an IRA custodian to The Catholic Foundation by December 15th to qualify as a 2022 rollover and be excluded from the donor's taxable income.
