GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Beginning with the original sin of Adam and Eve, humanity has lived in a way that has separated us from God's perfect love. Despite the many ways we have tried to draw near to God, it is impossible for us to repair this relationship on our own. The ways we turn away from God, therefore, require an outpouring of mercy and forgiveness, which our loving Father is eager to offer. When speaking of the grace that defeated the power of death, St. Paul reminds us in his Letter to the Romans that "the gift is not like the transgression." God's love for us is overflowing, and his desire to be in relationship with us is manifest in his giving his life for our salvation. Christ longs to heal and free us from the hold of sin in our lives, and we can experience this grace when we encounter Christ as the Divine Physician in the sacrament of reconciliation.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

In witness to the promise of eternal life and joy, we are called to live in a countercultural way, adhering to the words of the Gospel and the Tradition of the Church. We know this is not always easy. Yet, the Lord - through the prophet Jeremiah - reassures us that God is with us, and that he will be our "mighty champion." In the Gospel passage, Jesus speaks to the Apostles as they prepare to travel and preach the Good News. He warns them they will experience persecution, but he also reminds them that God is abundantly generous in his care for them. God cares for us in the same way as we continue our work of evangelization. He values us as precious children, and he promises that we will not be left alone in whatever challenges we may encounter while proclaiming the truth of his love.

PRAY

It can be difficult to rest in the promise of a love that exceeds our human faults and failings. It may seem impossible to be fully known and yet still exceedingly loved. The gift God offers us of being known, loved, and forgiven demonstrates a level of goodness that far exceeds any wrong we may have done. In your prayer this week, ask God for the grace to trust in this abundance of love that he desires to give to you.

Lessons from Fatherhood

Hello friends! My name is Sam Agra, and I serve as the part-time Parish Events Coordinator. I have loved this parish for a long time and am grateful for the opportunity to serve it. I found a home at St. Catharine's high school youth group while attending Bishop Hartley over a decade ago. I proposed to my wife in front of the Mary side altar over six years ago. When we returned to Columbus with our first baby after finishing my degree, we agreed that we wanted to raise our family here at the parish. A few years and children later, we are still so happy to be here. We are in love with the zeal, the liturgy, and the community of the parish. We hope for our family to be here for years to come.

Speaking of families, today is Father's Day. I am immensely grateful to my own father and the many men of this parish who have served as father figures to me. As a father myself, I can feel caught between the many roles I play for my wife, children, and workplaces. With three kids, three and under, there are a lot of spots to be filled. I often forget that my primary job is not that of husband, father, or employee, but that of son—a son of God.

In today's Gospel, Christ speaks of the great love the Father has for us. God knows the lives of all the sparrows, small though they might be. As we celebrate the fathers in our lives today, I pray that we might take a moment to listen to our heavenly Father and know the care He has for us.


