





#### Thank God for Seasons-All of Them

Thank God we have seasons. I don't know how people live in places without them. I'm not sure about you but every time a season changes I am ready to receive it. Don't get me wrong, I love Summer, but when

Fall hits I'm ready for sweater weather. And when Winter comes, I'm honestly ready for the snow. I grew up in upstate NY, I don't hate winter like some of you Ohioans!

Mother Church is so beautiful in that it has seasons as well and I am ready for a change in seasons! I'm ready to put the green prayer cloth away and pull out the purple. A related activity I mostly enjoy in



the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Atrium is the liturgical calendar. It depicts our Church's liturgical calendar, beautifully and colorfully illustrating the different feasts, seasons and Sundays of the year. The work of the child is to move all of the pieces from the board to the control chart and then restore the work back to its original board. Lots of little pieces = time & attention.

In my level 1 training, I avoided this work. I thought that I understood it and it seemed too monotonous to inspire thoughtful meditation, but the Lord kept prompting me to try it. Once I sat down and slowly moved each piece, I realized something. The Lord has good things in store for me in every single moment. Each little piece of our lives matter. When Sofia Cavaletti designed the CGS liturgical calendar work she felt like it ought to be counterclockwise as a sign that the church's calendar is meant to be counter-cultural. Advent can be one of those countercultural seasons that if we don't slow down we might just miss it. If we keep our eyes on anywhere but the Lord during this time we might just roll away with our Amazon cart.




For me, I have eyes right now on the building and opening of our Level 2 Atrium in early 2026. I have a lot of internal questions like, "How will I have the energy after the Christmas season to set this space up?", "What will this space look like when it is done?" "Am I ready for this expansion?" Much like a kid, waiting in anticipation for Christmas morning—I am waiting with mostly hopeful thoughts.

Pray for me this Advent that I can slow down and not worry about the next season yet. All we have to move is the small piece in front of us that the Lord is asking us to move. What is that piece for you? The good news is that He alone will provide the grace to move it.

#### First Sunday of Advent

nt DISCIPLE

Is 2:1-5 | Rom 13:11-14 | Mt 24:37-44

#### GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

For many in the upper latitudes of the northern hemisphere, this is the darkest time of the year, the time when the duration of daylight is at its lowest. It's providential, then, that our first reading calls us to "walk in the light of the Lord!" Paul tells us that we do this by "throw[ing] off the works of darkness" and "put[ing] on the armor of light." While we might not struggle with the vices listed in Paul's Letter to the Romans, each of us has our own struggles against sin. As we begin this Advent season, let us take time to do a thorough examination of conscience to discern areas of weakness and sin - those "works of darkness" Paul talks about - in our own lives. Then, consider taking up practices that help you to foster the opposing virtues to arm yourself against these temptations. As you grow in these virtues, you'll certainly be on your way up the mountain of the Lord and walking in his light!

#### **GO EVANGELIZE**

#### PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Today's Gospel calls us to vigilance. Jesus tells us, "Therefore, stay awake! For you do not know on which day your Lord will come." While he is speaking about our need to be ready to meet the Lord when he comes at the end of our lives, it's also an invitation for us to always be ready to share our faith with others whenever the opportunity presents itself. As Scripture says, we should "always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks you a reason for your hope." (1 Pet 3:15) We never know the moment when someone will come to us in need of prayer, a word of encouragement, or with questions related to their own spiritual hunger. We must always be ready to meet them where they are and offer a word of hope.

#### PRAY

Take a moment to pray this week for those "divine appointments" – those individuals who might come your way – seeking encouragement or insight into the spiritual questions in their lives. Ask for the grace to be "awake" so that you're ready to meet them when they come. We can't always predict when these encounters will happen, but we can prepare ourselves to receive these persons as Christ and offer them our full attention and love.




