

Sacrament Preparation at St. Catharine is for families, too! The whole family will experience the blessing of an encounter with Jesus when a child is preparing to receive a Sacrament of His love. Preparation for First Reconciliation and First Communion is a two year program, which can begin as early as 1st grade (to receive the Sacraments in 2nd grade). Preparation for Confirmation is also a two year program, and can begin as early as 7th grade (to be Confirmed in 8th grade. Register for Family of Faith when your child is ready for Sacrament preparation.
