Making Room for Jesus

On this Second Sunday of Advent, we hear the call to prepare the way of the Lord-not by doing more, but by slowing down. In a season that can become hurried and noisy with outside distractions, Advent reminds us to pause, breathe, and make room in our hearts for Jesus.



In our school community, students are learning that this preparation happens not only through prayer, but through daily acts of kindness, patience, and generosity toward one another. Our classrooms are abuzz with Advent traditions that help students understand the beauty of waiting with hope: lighting the candles on the wreath, reading from Scripture, and noticing the quiet ways that God is present in our day.

We also take this opportunity to be grateful for what we have been given, to spend time with family, and to spend time with Jesus. These simple acts remind us that God often speaks in quiet moments and that waiting with hope is an important part of our faith.

I want to personally thank you for your continued encouragement and prayers. The support of this community is truly amazing and together we can help our children grow in faith.



We are also deeply grateful for the many supports that strengthen our community. Our heartfelt appreciation goes to the Catholic Foundation for their continued generosity. The school has received a \$10,000 grant which allows us to begin some important security upgrades within the school and preschool. We also received a \$10,000 grant to run The Rescue Project in the Spring.





Second Sunday of Advent

Is 11:1-10 | Rom 15:4-9 | Mt 3:1-12

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE Today's Gospel is a challenging one, inviting us to consider how much spiritual fruit we are bearing in our lives. St. John the Baptist tells us, "Produce good fruit as evidence of your repentance," reminding us that the depth of our conversion will be measured by our fruit. Speaking to the Pharisees and Sadducees, John says it is not enough to say that "'We have Abraham as our father."" If he were speaking today, John might put it this way: it's not enough to say "I'm Catholic!" or "I belong to X Parish." Our lives must show outward evidence of the inward conversion we have undergone. The good news for us today is that we can pause and take stock of how well we are bearing spiritual fruit. Pay attention to what areas might need pruning or fertilizing to ensure that when we come to the Lord's threshing floor at the end of our lives, there is a bountiful harvest he can gather into his barn.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Our first reading gives us a glimpse of God's kingdom: The Son of David will rule with wisdom, understanding, counsel, and knowledge, judging "the poor with justice" and striking "the ruthless with the rod of his mouth." In his kingdom "the wolf shall be a guest of the lamb" and yet "there shall be no harm or ruin." What a poetic way of describing the harmony and wholeness that God longs for in society! As disciples, this is our mission. We're called to work so that God's kingdom vision can become reality. As we work for peace and justice, we're doing our part in the Church's work of evangelization. As the U.S. bishops reminded us in their letter *Communities of Salt and Light*, "social justice is an integral part of evangelization, a constitutive dimension of preaching the Gospel, and an essential part of the Church's mission."

REFLECT

In the Gospel, John the Baptist says of Jesus, "He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire." Our ability to bear spiritual fruit comes from the power of the Holy Spirit within us. Take a moment to reflect on where you see the gifts (see the first reading from Isaiah!) and fruits of the Holy Spirit in your life. How might the Spirit of God be working to increase your spiritual fruitfulness this Advent?



Turn Your Taxes into Scholarships for Catholic Education

with the Emmans Road Scholarship Fund

It's true! As a result of a law passed in 2021, Ohioans, like you, who make a gift to the Emmaus Road Scholarship Fund are eligible to receive a dollar-for-dollar credit - not a typical deduction - against your Ohio income tax liability, up to \$750 or \$1,500 if married, filing jointly. The law effectively gives you the power to direct your tax dollars to support Catholic education.

Why give? It is a philanthropic priority of the Diocese of Columbus to ensure an authentic Catholic education is affordable and accessible for all families. When you make a gift, you help



create scholarships for students to attend *Our Catholic Schools* and support our efforts to lead children to an encounter with Jesus Christ.

The Emmaus Road Scholarship Fund is a certified scholarship granting organization (SGO) in the state of Ohio.

Can this Tax Credit Benefit You?

Every person's situation is unique but you may be eligible to receive a tax credit by making a contribution to the Emmaus Road Scholarship Fund. The easiest place to start is by reviewing your most recent Ohio Income Tax Return. Then, follow these three, easy steps.

1 Pull your prior year return

The form you'll need to review is **Ohio IT 1040**.

2 Review line 8c on page 2

This is your total income tax liability *before credits*, or what the state says you owe as a taxpayer.

Is line 10 greater than \$0.00?

If so, you can reduce this liability on a dollar-for-dollar basis with a gift to the Emmaus Road Scholarship Fund, up to \$750 or \$1,500 if married and filing jointly.
