

Second Sunday of Lent

Gen 12:1-4a | 2 Tim 1:8b-10 | Mt 17:1-9

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

What struck me when I first read this passage from the Book of Genesis, in which the Lord speaks to Abraham, is God's proclamation that it is through *his will* and *his work* that the blessings and goodness of Abraham's future will come about. It is not a vague statement, in which the subject is omitted. God clearly says, "I will make your name great." Abraham was a faithful servant of God and sought to obey God's will, but that is not what made his name memorable. It is due to God's will and generosity that Abraham's blessings came about. I sometimes struggle with giving up credit for the good things in my life. I want to believe that *my work*, *my talents*, and *my dedication* have brought about these good things. But the reality is that all of who I am and the skills that I have is a gift. I was created by God and formed by others to hone certain dispositions and talents that have led to my accomplishments. When we come to realize that all we have is a gift, we are able to offer our lives back to be transfigured and glorified by God, who creates and gives all things.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Many scholars identify this moment of the Transfiguration as the climax of the narrative arc of the Gospels, after which Christ's actions lead to his suffering and death. In his passion, Christ demonstrates the ultimate submission to the will of God, taking on the weight of human sin in order to redeem us. In this moment of Transfiguration on the mountain, we glimpse the beauty of the glorification that will result from this perfect obedience to God's will. We, too, are called to surrender ourselves fully to God. Following Jesus' model of humble submission to the Father's will does not involve false humility, in which we are self-deprecating or overly critical of ourselves. Instead, we are called to acknowledge and celebrate our gifts and accomplishments, while also recognizing that who we are and the gifts that we have come from our generous and loving God.

REFLECT

Reflect on the gifts and talents you have been given, as well as the accomplishments that have come about because of these gifts. Take a moment to thank God for all that he has given to you, and ask him to reveal how you can be a witness to his goodness through the prudent use and celebration of these gifts.

Sing Your Way Through Lent

Lent is well underway and there are plenty of people I have heard saying what they are giving up as a sacrifice for repentance. There are many different answers from the students I teach. As for myself, there were (and are) things to give up for Lent. My problem was not with that, but with the "mandate" of no meat on Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of this season. Several years back I began to realize that maybe I need to add something else. I love any and all kinds of fish, so "no meat on Fridays" is not a sacrifice at all for me.



After a while, I figured maybe I could give my time to some organization. The Lancaster Knights of Columbus needed extra volunteers for their weekly Lenten fish fry. The K of C is involved in so many charitable donations and functions that promote the core values of the Church. They were also wise to give me a job on the floor – somehow they knew better than to put me in their kitchen!

We are in need of more members especially men. Our current choir is dedicated, very loyal, and loves to sing. We have had to overcome several problems with health issues and changing work schedules.

Here's the deal: please join us to help us enhance the beautiful liturgies all through Lent and the "high holy days" – the Triduum of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil. This all leads to the highest holy day, Easter, the central point of our faith in the risen Jesus Christ. Then, after that, you can decide whether to continue. The only extra time outside of the masses is 1½ to 2 hours on Monday nights (7–9 pm). Could you spare that much time? We would love to have you! "Singing is Praying Twice..."






