

St. Catharine Confirmation Preparation

Confirmation is the special outpouring of the Holy Spirit as once granted to the apostles on the day of Pentecost. (CCC #1302) The Sacrament of Confirmation unites us more closely with Jesus. We are strengthened with the Gifts of the Holy Spirit: wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord. We accept new responsibilities for serving Jesus in the world. What a beautiful Sacrament! Alyssa and Brayden Steller will work with families to prepare candidates to receive this special gift.

Practice of the Faith: It is presumed that candidates for Confirmation attend weekly Mass according to the laws and precepts of the Catholic Church.

Family of Faith: candidates for Confirmation should be regularly attending Family of Faith with their parents. Outside of the Sunday gatherings, families should complete several of the activities together each week.

Service: Candidates should spend time sharing their love of Jesus with others. It is really not enough to know about our Faith. We must put our Faith into practice in the world.

- Pray to the Holy Spirit for guidance.
- Talk to your parents to discuss ideas about how you can love your neighbor.
- Find out about ways you can help at St. Catharine or service organizations connected to the Church in our Diocese. You should also serve in your community and in your family, but please find some way to serve the Church as well.
- You will not have to "turn in" a certain number of hours this year, but you will be asked to write a reflection about what you have learned by serving Jesus and His Church.

May 7, 2022 Confirmation Mass at 10am

Candidates should dress appropriately for the Mass.

- **Girls:** dress (not sleeveless); modest length (past the fingertips when standing); no flip flops
- Boys: suit; dress shirt; tie; dress shoes

In order that the sanctity of the liturgy is preserved, it is requested that **no pictures** be taken during the Mass. A photographer will be hired and the photos will be shared with families at a later date.
