## Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

Dt 8:2-3, 14b-16a | 1 Cor 10:16-17 | Jn 6:51-58

### **GROW AS A DISCIPLE** | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

I'll never forget the first time I understood that the Eucharist does more than unite us to Jesus (a reality that is astonishing on its own). We profess in our creed that we're part of a communion of saints; every time we receive the Lord in holy Communion, we're drawn into a closer union with him and with all those who are members of his Body. St. Paul tells us that in partaking of the Body and Blood of the Lord, "we, though many, are one body, for we all partake of the one loaf." In a society where people are divided in so many ways, we're reminded of the Lord's burning desire - which he spoke of at the Last Supper - that we would all be one as he and the Father are one. (Jn 17:21) In giving us his very self in the Eucharist, Jesus has given us the means for achieving the unity he desires with us and for us. As we come forward to receive the Eucharist this Sunday, let us ask the Lord for the grace to grow in love and unity with all those who share this "one loaf."

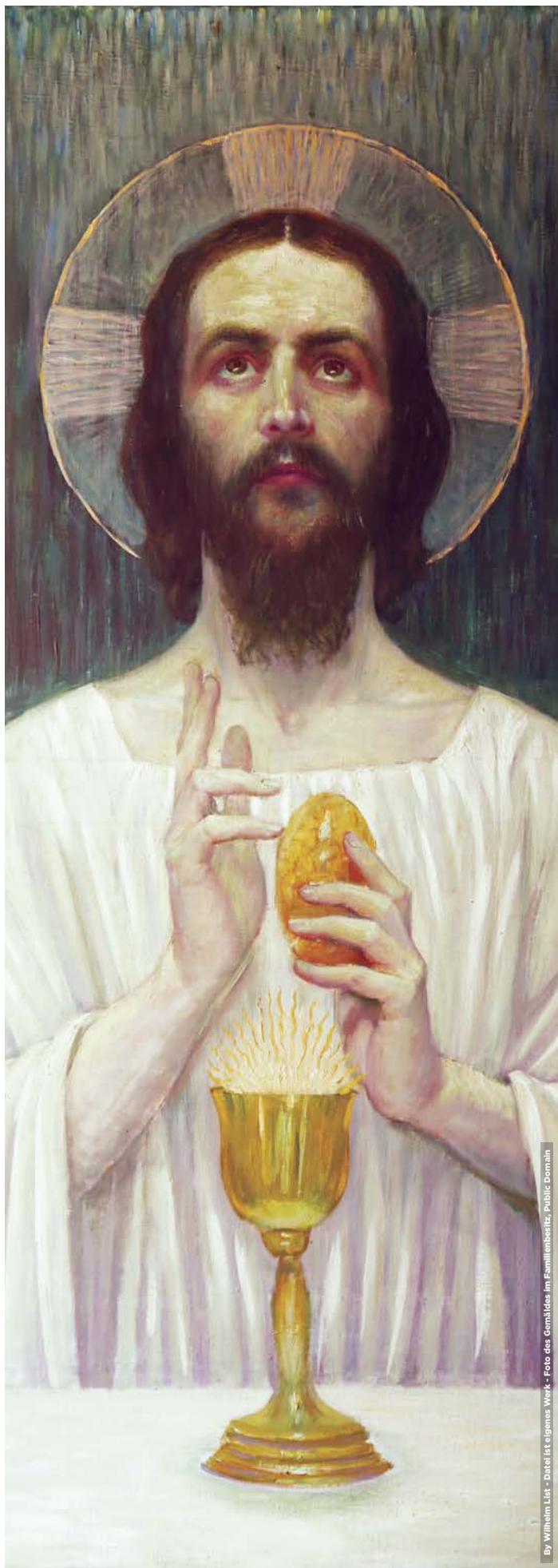
### **GO EVANGELIZE**

#### **PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT**

Like the Israelites wandering in the desert, our hearts long not only for physical bread, but for spiritual nourishment. Those who have come to know the Lord know that it is only the bread that he gives that can satisfy the hungers of our hearts. One of the best descriptions for evangelization I have heard is "one beggar telling another where the food is." We have access to food that offers life eternal. How can we keep such a feast to ourselves? Because the Eucharist is at the heart of our Christian life, it ought to factor heavily into our evangelization efforts. Think about ways you can share how the hungers in your life have been satisfied by the Lord in this sacrament.

### **PRAY**

The word Eucharist means thanksgiving. Today, take some time to thank the Lord for giving us his Body and Blood. You might consider praying with the Sequence (*Lauda Sion*) for today, a prayer of thanksgiving composed by St. Thomas Aquinas specifically for this solemnity. This beautiful sequence invites us to offer exuberant thanksgiving for this great gift: "*Full and clear ring out your chanting, / Joy nor sweetest grace be wanting, / From your heart let praises burst.*"

## Master, to Whom Shall We Go?

Dear Parish Family,

Today we celebrate one of the most important feasts of the Catholic year. In an age where people will only accept what is literally in front of them, or want to twist truth into what is untrue, belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist is, for many, a challenge. This is as true within the Church as it is outside it.

And yet, if we do not believe in this amazing transformation and gift, if we do not accept that what Jesus said in Scripture is true, then our faith is an empty shell, and our pilgrimage is in vain.

Our Lord told the people gathered that they must eat His flesh and drink His blood to have life within them. He was not speaking metaphorically. The original Greek is very clear. Language is important. Jesus uses the words for "eat" and "drink" that literally meant chewing on the flesh and bones and drinking down His blood. This is why so many of those who were following Him walked away disgusted. Even the idea of it was abhorrent to them.



And yet, this is clearly what Jesus wants His disciples to do. Not in a bloody way, but in a bloodless way through the Sacrament of His Body and Blood. And Jesus promised to feed us in this way until the end of time itself.

The readings today remind us of this important truth, but they also warn us not to be overconfident of our worthiness to receive. This is especially true of the second reading from Corinthians. Go back and read the whole chapter, and you will see that it is full of warnings. We must seek God's mercy always so that we receive Him in a state of grace, and refrain from receiving Him when we know we need confession first.

Regardless of what people think, receiving Holy Communion is not a right but a privilege. St. Paul makes this clear in 1 Corinthians 11—which is the oldest description in Scripture of the Last Supper—where he warns the Corinthians about the danger they face if they receive the Lord unworthily.

This parish is wonderful in recognizing our Lord's mercy in confession and His Real Presence in the Eucharist, but let's do all that we can to encourage others to come and believe, especially the younger members of our congregation, who are so often influenced by the swaying fashions of the world.

When the people were leaving Jesus, He asked the Twelve if they would leave too. Let us join today in claiming Peter's response to Jesus later in the Gospel passage at verse 68: "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life." Happy Feast!

## REFLECT

Abortion is always a tragedy that takes the life of an innocent child and significantly wounds the mother. For decades, surgical procedures accounted for most abortions, but today abortion by pill (also known as “chemical abortion” or, by proponents, “medication abortion”) is the most common form in the U.S. In a “chemical abortion,” a pregnant woman typically takes two pills, mifepristone and misoprostol, a day or two apart, to kill and then expel a developing child from her womb. This form of abortion not only takes the life of a child but also poses significant risks to the health and safety of women.

Despite these risks, chemical abortion is widespread. Since 2016, the FDA has disregarded women’s health by loosening safety standards, extending the limits of when mifepristone can be used, and decreasing the number of required doctor’s visits. More recently, the FDA has allowed abortion pills to be prescribed in virtual appointments and sold both at neighborhood pharmacies and online, enabling a nationwide mail-order abortion industry. These policies leave women vulnerable to suffering an abortion at home, alone, without any medical

supervision. In addition to putting a woman’s health at risk, the actions taken by the FDA also increase the chances that women may be exploited by violent partners and human traffickers undetected.

There are currently three major federal lawsuits, led by states with pro-life laws, challenging the FDA and seeking to restore limitations on mifepristone or undo its availability altogether. On May 14, the Supreme Court allowed the abortion pill to remain available by video appointment and mail-order while at least one of the lawsuits proceeds. While this setback was disappointing, we pray that the states will ultimately prevail in protecting women and preborn children from the dangers of the abortion pill.
