

Message from Rachel Green

Reckless Love and My Reluctant Heart

I'm just going to go ahead and say it. When I get mad or upset at someone, especially ones that I love the most, I don't let it go very easily (just ask my husband.) This is vulnerable for me to say, and it's not something that I am proud of, but maybe the Lord is prompting me to write about this because you might struggle with the same thing.



I still have memories of this fault as a child. When I'd get mad at my Mom, I'd sulk and turn inward and want to run away to my room, just waiting for her to be the first one to apologize. Unfortunately I don't think a whole lot has changed. I still turn inward and go to thoughts of desolation when someone hurts me—I throw myself an inner pity-party and want to "run away" from the problem. I isolate myself and cope in a way that doesn't always look for resolution immediately.

On this Trinity Sunday, (which is also fittingly Father's day) God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit want to show us all a better way. The Holy Trinity is like a unified family that never looks to divide. One of the activities in the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Atrium exemplifies this "perfect" love very well. It's commonly referred to as the Lost Sheep parable but in the atrium, we call it the "Found Sheep" parable (Luke 15: 3-7.) You probably know the parable by now and for many it can seem like nothing new. You know, the one where the Good Shepherd leaves the 99 sheep alone in the desert to search for the ONE lost sheep, no big deal...WAIT?! He leaves how many sheep alone and in danger to just find one little lost sheep? Why? Well because His love for his sheep is crazy. He delights in each one.

After we present this we ask, "Do you think that the Good Shepherd ever stops looking?" The children all quickly answer a resounding, "No!" Then we ask the question, "What does the Good Shepherd do when he finds the lost sheep? Does he yell and scold him?" The answer is always another, "No!" Rather he picks the sheep up like a good Father and sets it on His shoulders bringing the sheep home. Then He practically throws a party—rejoicing because He has found His lost sheep.

I hate to say this but this is not how I always show love. It might be the competitive, athletic side of me, but if someone runs away from me or causes me grief and pain, I don't quickly go chasing after the opponent. Something that I often say to my two year-old lately is, "Mommy doesn't chase!" But this is exactly what the Good Shepherd does, in an effort to bring you and I home to the Trinity. The lyrics of one of my favorite songs, "Reckless Love" by Cory Asbury captures this trinitarian love...

Oh, it chases me down, fights 'til I'm found, leaves the 99 I couldn't earn it, and I don't deserve it, still, You give Yourself away Oh, the overwhelming, never-ending, reckless love of God

I don't know what your relationship with your earthly father looks like. It might resemble this love of the Holy Trinity. Or it might not. Either way, take some time today to realize that you are that one sheep that the Good Shepherd would chase down and look for without stopping. You and I both have a very Good Father waiting for us in heaven and looking down on us with delight and love today. Ask God the Father today to send His Holy Spirit to you so that you can resemble His Son more closely when you are brought home someday on His shoulders. Oh and don't worry, there will be a party just for you.

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity Written by THE FAITHFUL DISCIPLE

Prov 8:22-31 | Rom 5:1-5 | Jn 16:12-15

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Between two people who love each other, speech often gives way to silence. But first, in order to nourish love, there must be a mutual exchange of words. Persons in love wish to share their most intimate secrets so that they might know and be known. In an act deserving of our endless wonder, God disclosed his most intimate secret to us: He is a communion of Persons - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit - who relate to each other in an eternal exchange of love. St. Thomas Aquinas insisted that the Trinity is not a reality we could have figured out on our own (in contrast to, for example, God's existence which we can know simply by examining creation). God had to reveal his Trinitarian nature to us. While humanity was wandering further and further away from him over the millennia after the Fall, God was preparing us for the revelation of the Son and the Holy Spirit. This is what Jesus is announcing in today's Gospel: "Everything that the Father has is mine: for this reason I told you that [the Holy Spirit] will take from what is mine and declare it to you." To his bewildered disciples, Jesus is expressing God's intention to communicate his identity to us - an unmerited gift which he offers simply because he loves us.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

This is our inheritance as Christians: God has revealed himself to us out of love. Once we've assented to this truth, we can no longer dismiss the mystery of the Holy Trinity as "above my theological paygrade." One who loves is not bothered that the beloved always remains a mystery; instead, he or she is content to remain in wonder and seeks to enter more deeply into the exchange of love. For us, this means responding to God's gift of himself with reverence, gratitude, and obedience to his will. We approach him in prayer with the respectful but confident attitude of a child who knows itself to be deeply loved; we listen to him, express our thanksgiving for his gift, and seek to know his will for us.

PRAY

Be attentive to the ways God is revealing himself and his love for you in your daily life. Discover that *everything* is an expression of his care: answered prayers, a kind word given or received, the beauty of nature — even crosses which induce us to turn to him for help! Take a few minutes each day to thank God for his gifts.


